We're now exploring The Three Little pigs. This week, we'll be building structures and attempting to work out the best way to make them strong.

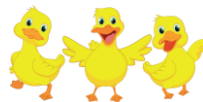
We'll also be playing with pigs in mud that suspiciously smells like chocolate. We plan to create some junk model buildings of our own too.
